
So I was at Walmart earlier.

A lady was looking at frozen turkeys, but she couldn't find one big enough.



Made my week.




It's been a bit of a strange day!

The woman said she would try her best.


God visited her a week later to see how she was getting on.


"Then the middle wife starts saying 'push, push,' and 'breathe, breathe.'"
